On Teak

Teak is more than a material, it's a foundation. Prized for its natural oils, durability, and golden warmth, teak has been trusted for centuries in shipbuilding, architecture, and furniture that stands the test of time.

We choose teak not just for its strength, but for its soul. Its rich grain tells a story. It weathers beautifully, softening to a silvery patina while retaining its integrity and character.

Our process begins decades before it's built; grown with care, seasoned with time, and shaped through a meticulous process of drying, matching, and finishing that honors both the material and where it comes from.





Sustainability Efforts

Not all teak is created equally. In some parts of the world, forests are cleared with no plans for renewal, leaving behind bare land and a broken supply chain.

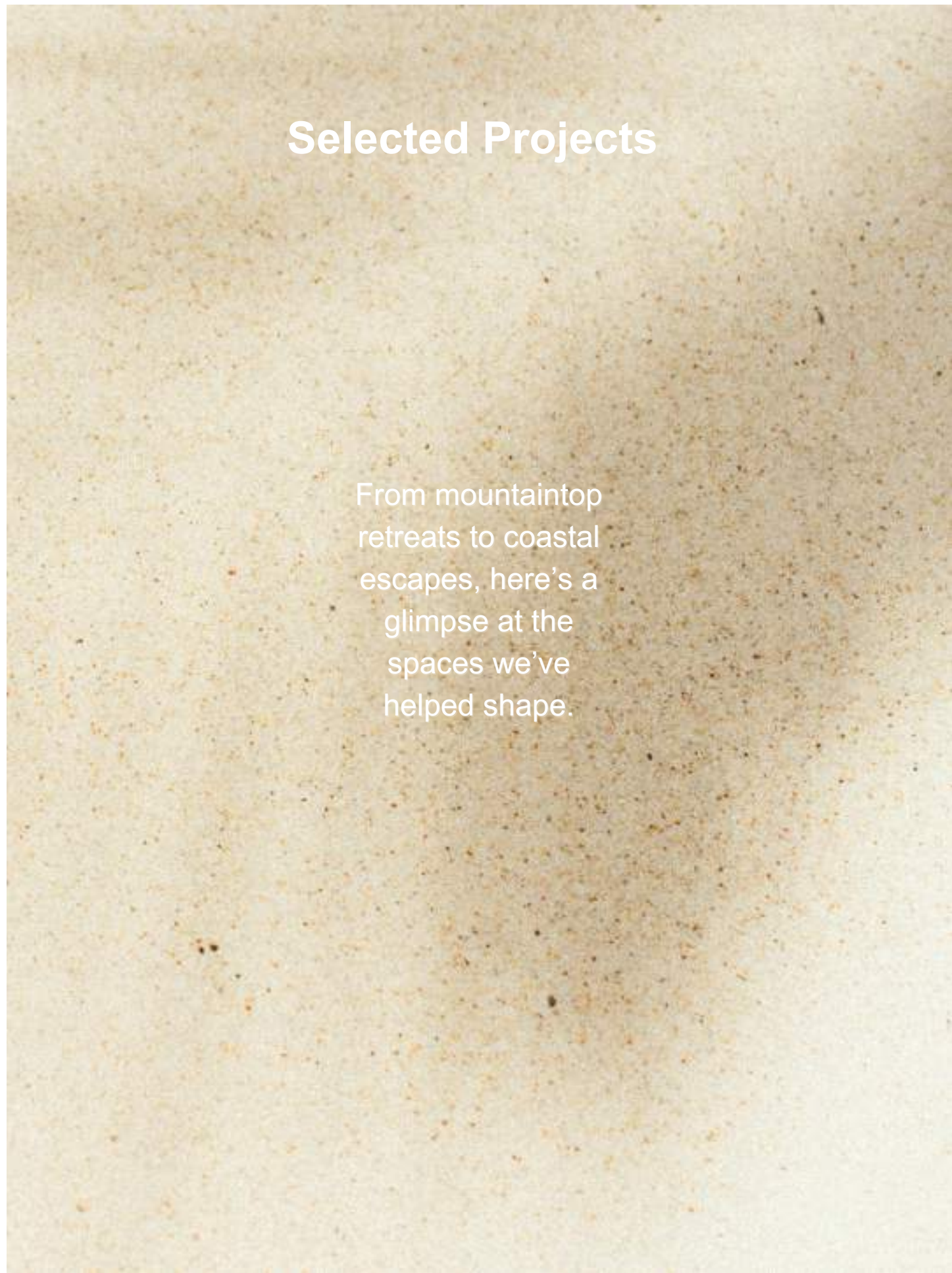
We use government managed Indonesian plantation teak, grown with intention, harvested with precision, and replanted for future generations. These plantations are mapped out 60 years in advance, ensuring that every tree we use has a purpose and a successor. It's a model that protects ecosystems, supports local communities, and keeps the cycle thriving.

By choosing sustainably grown teak, we support a system where using wood leads to more trees, not fewer. Wildlife flourishes among the groves. Farmers grow crops in the shade. And entire villages benefit from the stability of a long term industry.

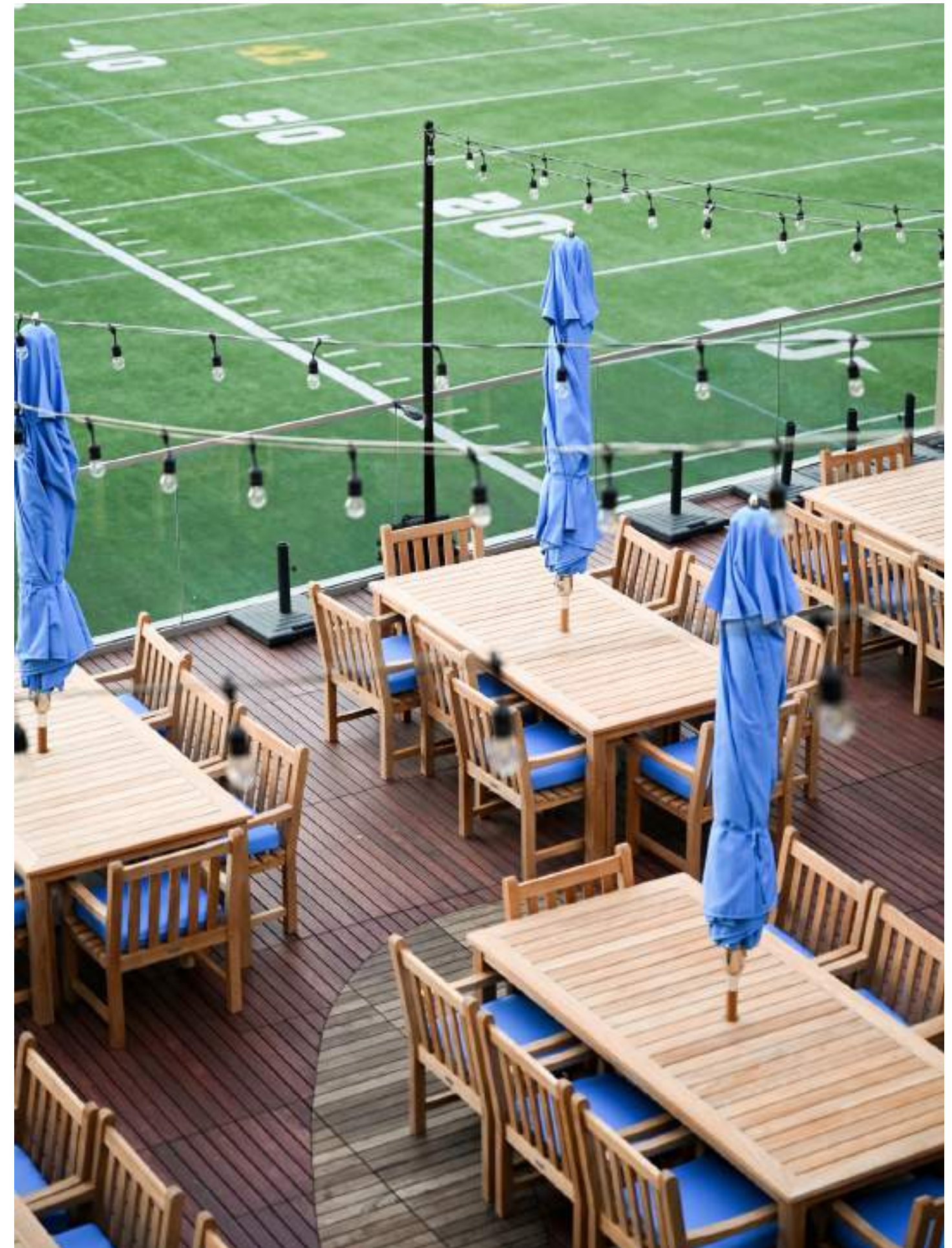




UCLA Wasserman Football Center

UCLA's Wasserman Football Center is a state of the art training facility designed to support both performance and community. The outdoor dining space features solid teak rectangular tables paired with wide, deep seating armchairs, thoughtfully scaled to accommodate players, alumni, and guests. Custom Bruin Blue dining chair cushions and umbrellas add a tailored touch, reinforcing the identity of the space.

Eighteen dining sets, each seating eight, are distributed across the custom Ipe viewing deck and coach's suite, overlooking the full practice field. Designed as a place to gather, the patio provides a durable, sustainable setting where team members can relax and share daily meals, while also serving as an inviting, informal meeting space for recruits and their families.





Fahl Aquatics Center

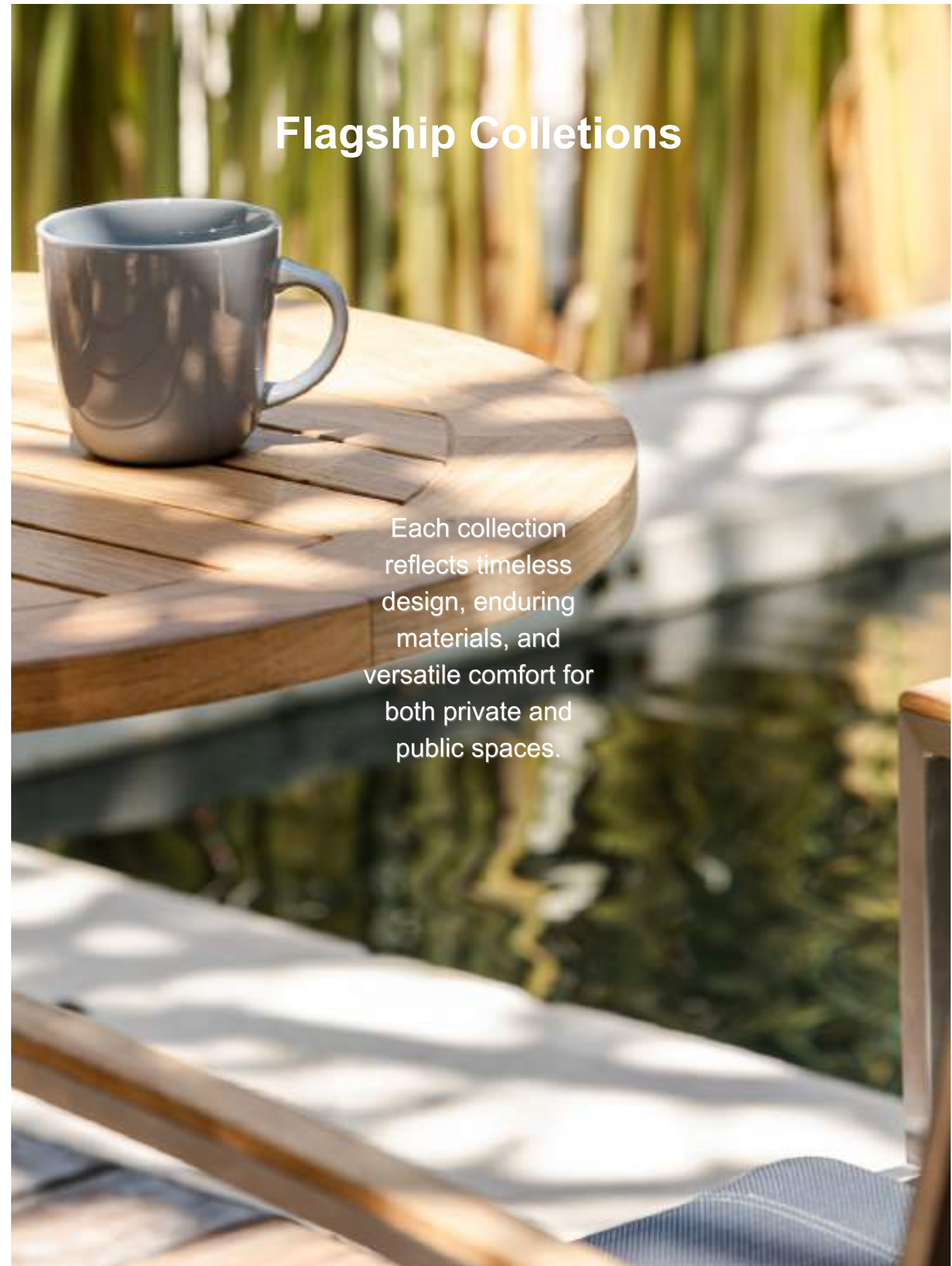


The Cliff House

Cushions are crafted in house using layered foam and Dacron cores, covered in Sunbrella® fabric for lasting comfort and performance.

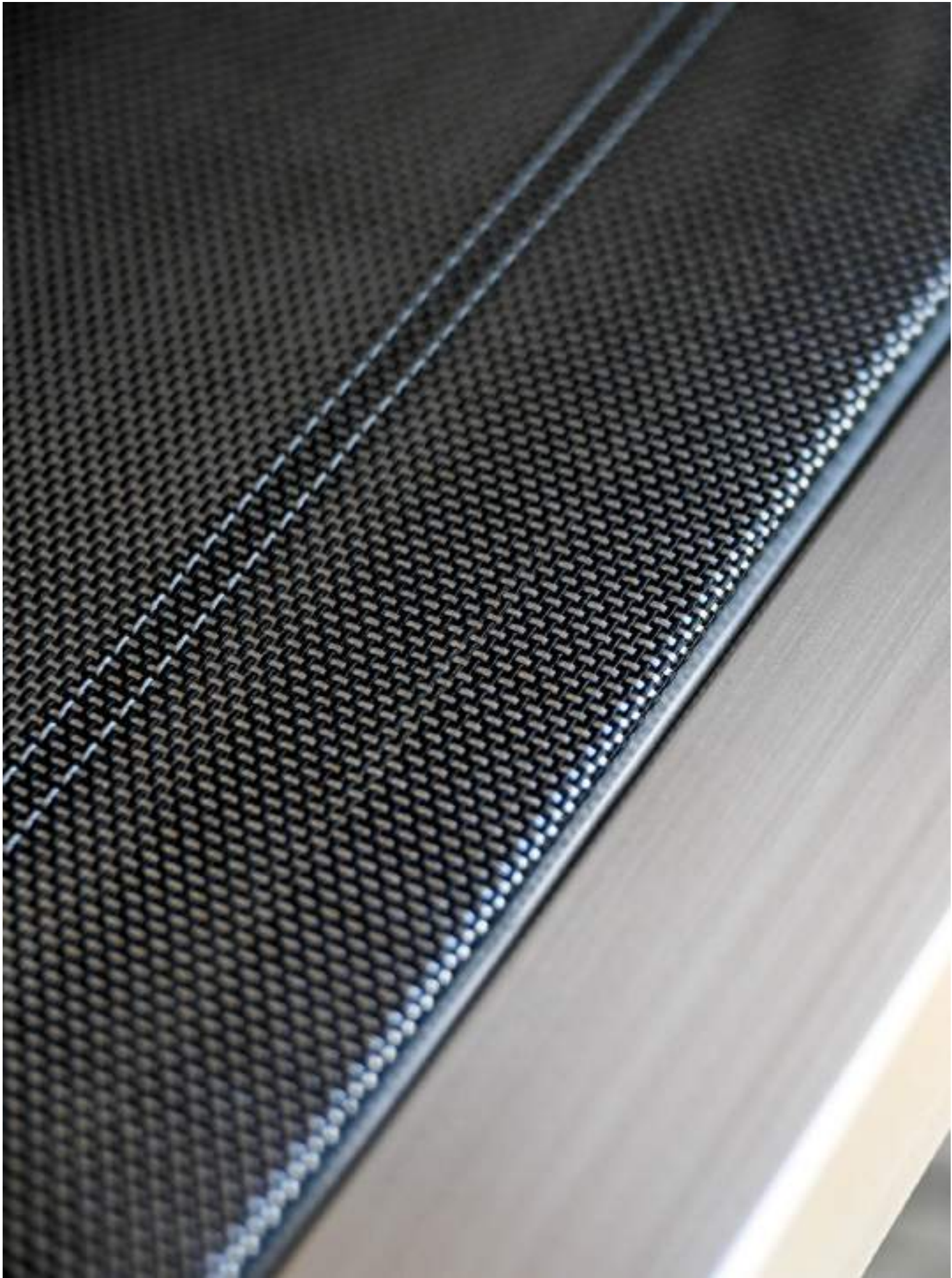




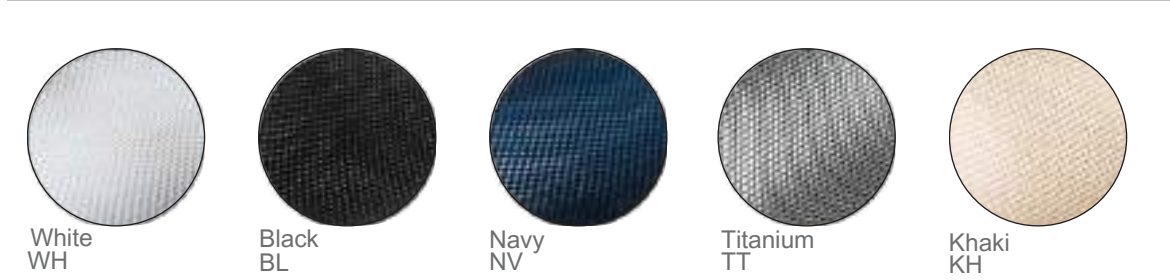


Fabrics & Finishes

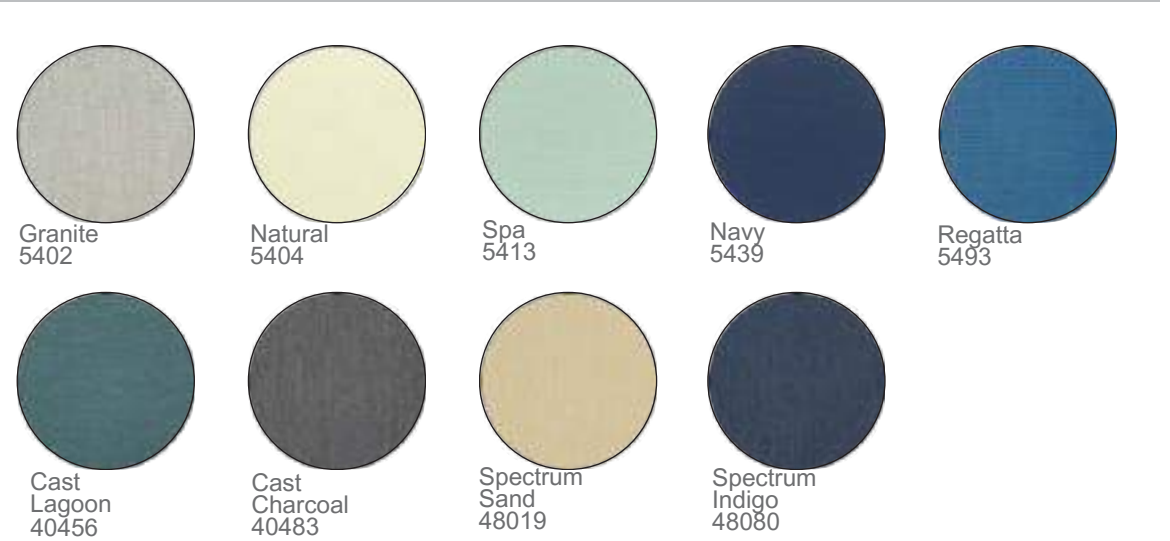


Sling

Quick Ship Cushions



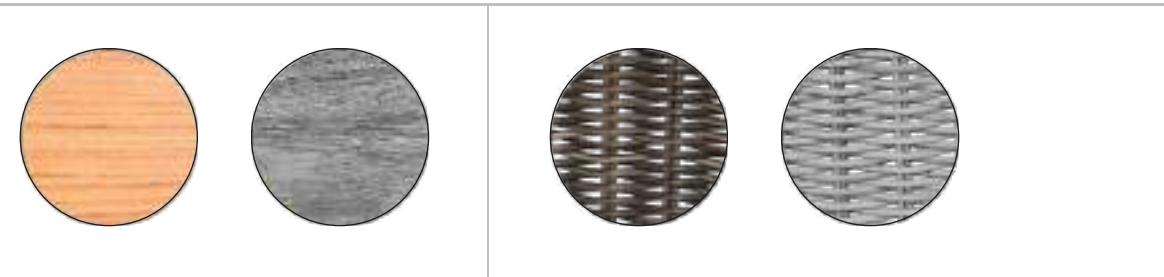
